Homestays or Supervised Residences*

Students can stay with host families or supervised residences. Both offer a safe, supportive environment to immerse in Japanese culture and focus on learning.

*Supervised Residences have limited availability, and those for ages 14-15 are currently full, with a waiting list available. If no space is available, a homestay will be arranged.

Airport Pick-Up

A representative will greet the student at the airport and take them safely to their accommodation. We can also coordinate with Unaccompanied Minor Services provided by airlines, ensuring a smooth, worry-free arrival.
